The levels are numbered in increasing order from level A1, the lowest level of functional competence, to C2, the highest level of advanced proficiency. The levels are conceived as lying on a continuum, with C2 lying at the far end of the continuum. A student can move up or down the scale. A1: Basic functional competence A1 corresponds to BEC Preliminary or to PET B2. It corresponds to the lowest level of functional competence. Although many textbooks for B2 correspond to A1, this is an approximation and for a more complete overview, see the table below.

A2: Intermediate functional competence A2 corresponds to BEC Preliminary or PET B2. It corresponds to the lowest level of intermediate functional competence. B1: Pre-academic competence B1 corresponds to BEC PET or KET C1. It corresponds to the lowest level of academic competence, roughly equivalent to the native speaker's basic level of English.
